Finder S.p.A. with sole shareholder ("Finder") recognizes the importance of protecting the privacy and personal data of all subjects with whom it interacts, in compliance with current regulations - General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR - EU Regulation 2016/679) and the Italian Personal Data Protection Code (Legislative Decree no. 196/2003) - including the ISO/IEC 27701 standard. This Privacy Policy outlines the way in which Finder processes personal data to ensure confidentiality, integrity and availability of information.



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
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This Privacy Policy applies to all personal data processing carried out by Finder, using electronic or paper tools, concerning:

- Employees, Employee's Spouse, Family Members and Dependents;
- Job Applicants, Prospective Collaborators, Collaborators and Interns;
- Visitors and Users of Online Systems;
- Customers, Suppliers, Employees, Partner or Third Party Companies, Public Administrations, Private Citizens, Other Stakeholders;
- Reporting Persons, Persons Concerned, Third Persons, Facilitators;
- Subjects filmed by the video surveillance system in company areas.

Finder commits to:

- Ensuring the compliance of personal data processing with current regulations;
- Protecting the rights of data subjects;
- Ensuring transparency and clarity on how data is processed.



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The processing of personal data by Finder is based on the following principles:

- 1. Lawfulness, fairness and transparency: Data is processed in a legal, ethical and transparent manner in relation to the Data Subjects;
- 2. Purpose limitation: Personal data is collected for explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes.
- **3. Data minimization**: Only data strictly necessary for the specified purposes is collected.
- 4. Accuracy: Data is kept up to date and correct.
- **5. Storage limitation**: Data is stored only for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of the processing.
- 6. **Integrity and confidentiality**: Data is processed ensuring an appropriate level of security to prevent unauthorized access, loss or damage.
- 7. Accountability: Finder adopts appropriate technical and organizational measures to demonstrate the compliance of data processing with applicable regulations.



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
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Finder processes the following categories of personal data:

- Identification data (tax code, images (photo/video), name, surname, gender, date and place of birth, residence, phone number);
- Contact data (email, phone number, address, province, country);
- Contractual and payment data (bank details, tax data, contract details, profession, any additional personal data contained in the proof of purchase, accumulated points and rewards granted);
- **Professional data** (job position, curriculum vitae, personal information voluntarily communicated by the Data Subject, fitness for work);
- Sensitive data within the limits set by law (medical certificates for work purposes, personal information voluntarily communicated by the Data Subject);
- Browsing data (technical browsing data, statistical information on website usage, information described in the cookie policy);
- **Personal data** provided in the **report** or in information subsequently provided by the reporting person;
- Personal data necessary for the exercise of rights;
- Personal data whose communication is required by law or by order of the Public Authority.



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
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- To respond to requests from the Data Subject sent through the contact channels available on the website;
- Proper and complete execution of the contractual relationship with Customers and Suppliers, surveys on service satisfaction;
- Compliance with legal, administrative, accounting, tax obligations of the Data Controller;
- Human resources and work relationships management;
- Guarantee of physical and IT security;
- Marketing and promotional communications, subject to express consent, participation in prize operations and the execution of related activities;
- Management and handling of whistleblowing reports;
- Protection of the safety of people and property within the company areas;
- Anonymous statistical analysis;
- Collection, use and storage of images for informational purposes and potentially promotional purposes regarding Finder's activity;
- Protection of rights.





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
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- Pre-contractual measures adopted at the request of the Data Subject;
- Performance of a contract in existence or under negotiation between the parties;
- Compliance with a legal obligations;
- Consent of the Data Subject, where required;
- Legitimate interest of the Data Controller, in compliance with the fundamental rights and freedoms of the Data Subjects;
- Art. 122 Legislative Decree 196/2003 consent not necessary.



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In accordance with the ISO/IEC 27701 standard, Finder has implemented a Privacy Information Management System (PIMS), which may include:

- Encryption or pseudonymization of personal data;
- Access controls based on the principle of least privilege;
- Data backup and recovery procedures;
- Periodic audits to verify the effectiveness of security measures;
- Continuous training of staff on security and privacy topics.



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
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- Access to their personal data;
- Rectification of inaccurate or incomplete data;
- Erasure of data (right to be forgotten);
- Restriction of processing;
- Data portability;
- Objection to processing, for legitimate reasons;
- Withdrawal of consent, where applicable.



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Personal data may be shared with:



- Public Authorities and Competent Authorities, where required by law;
- Suppliers and Partners involved in the services provided by Finder;
- Finder Group companies, in compliance with the stated purposes.

In the case of data transfers to non-EEA countries, Finder ensures compliance with the provisions of the GDPR by adopting standard contractual clauses or other appropriate measures.
